7. Get of sire: three does by one sire, may be any age
8. Produce of Dam: two daughters, any age of one mother
- 8a. Dam & daughter
9. Best of Breed –(trophy) this will consist of all the first place goats from each of the preceding classes.
10. Reserve Champion

### DAIRY AND OBERHASLI TYPE GOATS:

11. 0-6 months
12. 6 months – 1 year
13. Dry yearling (not yet in milk)
14. Yearling in milk
15. 2 year old in milk
16. 3 year old in milk
17. 4 – 5 year old in milk
18. Aged does (over 5)
19. Get of sire: three does from one sire (father) may be any age, and may have different dams
20. Produce of dam: two does from the same dam (mother) may be any age
21. Dam & daughter
22. Best Udder
23. Reserve Champion (Rosette & prize money)
24. Best of Breed: this will consist of all the first place winners from each of the preceding classes for dairy type goats
25. Grand Champion (Best Goat in Show): the first place champions in meat, pygmy oberhasli and dairy goats compete in these challenges(Trophy & prize money)
26. Costume class – all types of goats! Ribbons awarded for: Most original, most comical, most elaborate

Does reported to have kidded this year, though not in milk presently, may be shown in the milking classes.

All goats will be released following the awarding of premiums at the end of the show. Rules of the show are according to the ADGA standards.
