

12. In cases where there is only one exhibit per lot or class, exhibitor will receive 1st place ribbon and premium.

13. All cattle must be tied in stalls in barn provided with halters and neck ropes no longer than three (3) feet to show. (In the event there is no stalls available in barn, cattle may be tied to fence.)

14. Shavings for bedding will be furnished.

15. Safety: Everything possible will be done to prevent accidents; however, if any should occur, neither the Sevier County Fair, nor fair personnel, nor other persons, nor any other organizations connected with the management of Sevier County Fair assumes any liability, either legal or otherwise to persons or property.

16. Cattle must be washed only in the designated wash area.

17. ALL cattle MUST enter show ring to receive premium money.

Class 01: Junior Beef Cattle Showmanship

General Rules for Junior Beef Cattle Showmanship

1. All 4-H and FFA members are eligible who are qualified to exhibit cattle in 4-H and FFA Beef Cattle shows – Refer to Rules 7 and 8 in general rules for Beef Cattle Junior and Open Shows.

2. Judging to be based on ability to:

- A. Present Cattle to the judge
- B. Follow show ring procedure
- C. Control their cattle
- D. Groom cattle for show

3. Premiums: Ribbons for all exhibitors, trophy for first place exhibitor

Lot 1 – Junior – grades 4, 5, 6 January 1 current year

Lot 2 – Junior High – grades 7, 8, 9 January 1 current year

Lot 3 – Senior High – grades 10, 11, 12 January 1 current year
